3 ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES of March 5, 2014 . These were accepted as a true record - Cllr A Holmes proposing and Cllr A Evans seconding.

4 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

4.1 Dol Fraint, Star (path) - A letter was read from the County Council stating that the Council is in the process of forcing the applicant to carry out the work.

4.2 Speeding Star - An email from the County Council stated the Traffic Section has recently conducted a survey and from these results have decided to offer a speed limit of 30mph. it was decided to move forward - all in favour

4.3 Speed Penmynydd - A response was read from the County Council stating they are monitoring the speed of vehicles on the B5420 and will compare the results with statistics before the changes . In addition they will assess official statistics on road accidents over the next year . That process has already begun . They have also sought the views of other officials within the Service (including the Head of Service) and others who are travelling the road. The view is that the changes will better reflect the nature of the way , although some of them complained that the 40 mph band will still be too long .After gathering this information , they will consult the Community Council meeting to discuss the way forward .Because of complaints about the order and speeding cars , it was decided to move forward and hold a public meeting on May 7 at 7 pm in Hall at Penmynydd . The Clerk will offer an invitation to the Police
